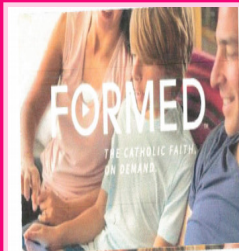

Dear Friends,

Many people (hopefully including you) pray the Stations of the Cross during Lent. Some people pray them all year long. The Fourteen moments for meditation that they provide are a special way to reconnect with the reality of what Jesus did for us. They invite us to walk with Him. They are a way to accompany Him. They can bring meaning and fruitfulness to the different experiences of our day and of our days. Try this experiment: name each of the Stations in your mind. Can you do it? In the correct order? If so, it can make a nice personal prayer at any time of the day. The Fourteen Stations of the Cross can be on your mind and in your heart even when you are stuck in traffic beside the same gas station for too long a time. Try to find the connections between what Jesus did for you and what you can do for Him.

On today's cover is an image from the Cathedral church in the city of Leon, Nicaragua. The church dates back to the 1740's and boasts some enormous special paintings of the Fourteen Stations. Station #2 is the one I have chosen for your attention and reflection today. Notice how Jesus accepts His Cross. The Spanish text points out that it is a heavy Cross. Jesus is clearly embracing it in an **eager** way. Think now, please, of your daily crosses and maybe of your Lenten sacrifices. Can you say that you are approaching them in an eager way? If not, make a point this week to bring that reality to Jesus. Bring it straight to Him in prayer. Reflect on the way He did everything out of a deep love, a deep love for us. Sacrifice must have love or it becomes something bitter and empty. Find the fruitfulness in the sacrifices available to you each day. Embrace with enthusiasm the chances you have to learn to love like Jesus.

This week we are thrilled and blessed to have Father Terry Messer and Father Juniper Adams with us to conduct our **Parish Mission**. Please give them all of your attention and plan to come this Monday through Wednesday to either the morning conference (8:45 AM Mass with Conference) or the evening conference (7 PM Conference with Holy Hour). On Wednesday evening we will have the Closing Mass at 7 PM.

Mucha gente (espero que ustedes incluidos) oran el viacrucis durante la cuaresma. Algunas personas lo rezan todo el año. Los catorce momentos de meditación que provee son una manera especial de reconectar con la realidad de que Jesús murió por nosotros. Ellos nos invitan a caminar con Él. Son una manera de acompañarlo. Le traen sentido y fruto a las diferentes experiencias de nuestro día y días. Hagan este experimento: nombren cada una de las estaciones en su mente. Pueden hacerlo? En el orden correcto? Si es así, esta puede ser una bella oración personal a cualquier hora del día. Las catorce estaciones de la cruz pueden estar en sus mentes y corazones aún cuando están atrapados en tráfico junto a la misma estación gasolinera por mucho rato. Traten de encontrar conexiones entre lo que Jesús hizo por ustedes lo que ustedes hacen por Él.

La portada de hoy es una imagen en la iglesia de la Catedral en la ciudad de Leon, Nicaragua. La iglesia existe desde los 1740s y se jacta de unas pinturas especiales y enormes de las catorce estaciones. Yo escogí la estación #2 para llamar su atención y reflexión es este día. Noten como Jesús acepta su cruz. El texto en español señala que es una cruz pesada. Jesús es claramente aceptándola con **ansias**. Piensen ahora, por favor, en sus cruces diarias y quizás sus sacrificios cuaresmales. Pueden decir que las están aceptando de manera ansiosa? Si no, propónganse esta semana traer esa realidad a Jesús. Tráiganla directo a Él en oración. Reflexionen en la manera que Él hizo todo por amor profundo, y profundo amor por nosotros. El sacrificio debe tener amor o se convierte en algo amargo y vacío. Encuentren los frutos en los sacrificios de cada día. Acepten con entusiasmo los cambios que tienen que aprender para amar como Jesús.

Esta semana estamos muy animados y bendecidos por tener al Padre Terry Messer y el Padre Juniper Adams con nosotros para conducir nuestra **Misión Parroquial**. Por favor préstenles toda su atención y hagan planes de venir de este lunes a miércoles ya sea a la conferencia de la mañana (Misa de 8:45 AM con conferencia) o en la noche (conferencia y hora santa). El miércoles en la noche tenderemos la misa de cierre a las 7 PM.
